

## COURT REFERRAL DUI SERVICES

Our Court Referral DUI program maintains offices in the Van Nuys, San Fernando, Santa Clarita Court and Burbank courts to monitor all individuals convicted of a DUI offense required to complete a court-ordered, state-approved Alcohol Program.

NCADD works with the court to:

- Provide referral to the appropriate state licensed DUI program, including all accompanying documentation
- Notify courts on the enrollment process
- Report client attendance and progress
- Notify court of completion, client terminations for non-compliance, or re-enrollment

A fee is charged for these services which are dependent on the length of program set by the court and are established by the Los Angeles County Office of Alcohol Programs.

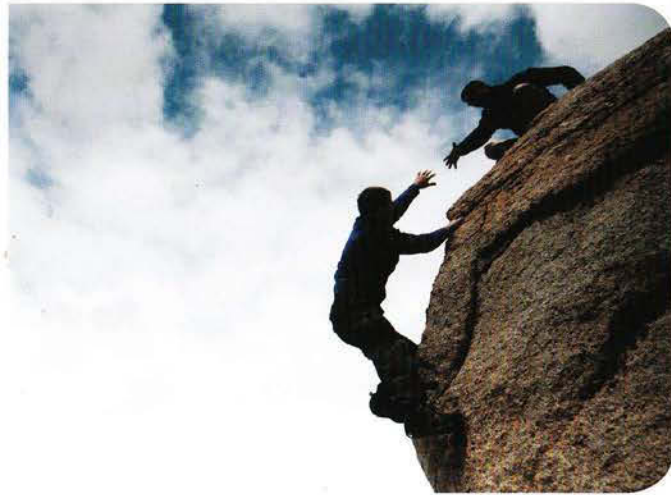

Participants are able to receive treatment while living at home and going to work or school.

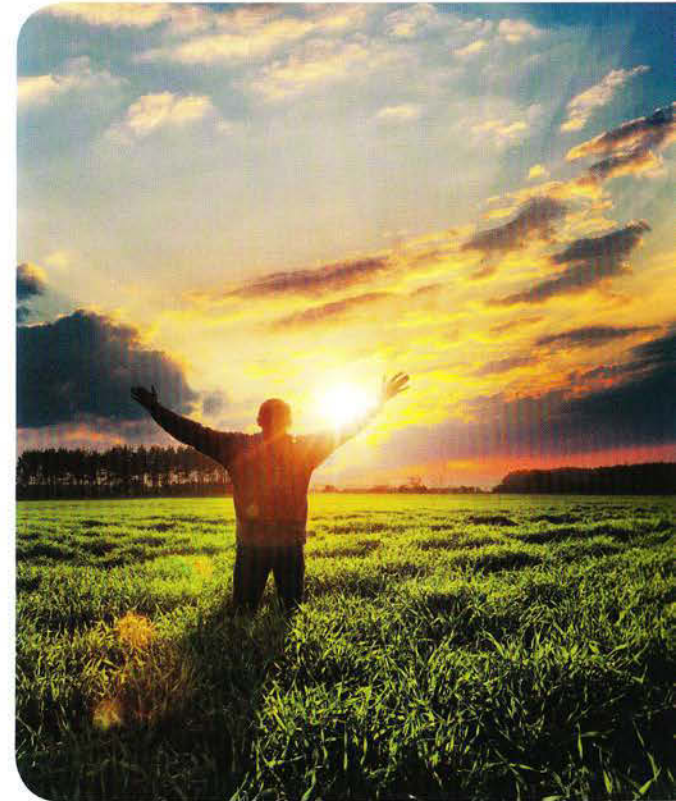
